The U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) has stated repeatedly and unequivocally that marijuana has no medical value, and consequently has classified it as a Schedule I controlled substance, along with heroin – even though the synthetic drug Marinol, with the same psychoactive ingredient, is classified in Schedule III.
